

AGRICULTURE

Supporting agriculture helps to improve food security for both families and communities. Gifts like goats and chickens provide families with nutrition and a stable source of income.

GOAT \$80

For protein and income, consider the impact of giving the gift of a goat! These hardy animals are easy to care for, breed quickly, and are an excellent source of income for families. Goats are a great starting point for growing a herd that will support a family for years to come. This gift will help provide a farming family with a healthy goat through a local pass-a-long program and includes a veterinarian check-up.

CHICKENS \$25

Three chicks grow up to lay 1,000 eggs a year - a reliable source of food and income that families can count on. This gift provides a family with healthy and vaccinated chickens to start a coop.



CHICKENS FOR A COMMUNITY \$75

In remote communities in Canada's North the high cost of food makes it challenging to keep a family fed with healthy meals. This is especially difficult during winter months when some communities are only accessible by air. This gift provides funding to Indigenous communities to maintain a chicken coop and buy chicken feed to support a sustainable food source for the entire community.



START A FAMILY FARM \$299

Fill the barnyard with livestock and empower a woman with skills and techniques to grow fruit, veggies, and healthy herds of animals. Her family and community reap the benefits, as she contributes to building a better world. This gift includes livestock through a local breeding program, animal care and gardening training, and garden tools.



SHEEP \$65

Sheep are hardy sources of protein that become essential assets and bring in sustainable income. This gift provides a family with a sheep and veterinarian care as part of a pay-it-forward program to help build their flock, increase their family income, and improve food security.



PIGLET \$50

Pigs are an easy and affordable animal to farm, which makes them a good choice to supply affordable protein. Your gift will provide animals, training and care to a teaching farm in an Indigenous community in Canada to provide youth with the opportunity to learn about farming and the community with a sustainable food source.

Give a gift at home in Canada! Gifts like nutritious meals and community gardens help Indigenous children and families access the food they need and stay connected with their traditions.

SCHOOL MEALS \$75

2X MATCHED POPULAR

A nutritious meal helps refuel for better learning! Your contribution to school nutrition programs helps to improve educational outcomes and increases food security for children. This gift provides one month of school meals for an Indigenous child in Canada.



FOOD PRODUCTION & PRESERVATION \$25

Food preservation helps to increase food security by building local food systems in Indigenous communities. Your gift will supply equipment and materials for learning workshops and canning circles to preserve local food through canning and smoking. The preserved food will then be distributed to community members.



COMMUNITY & SCHOOL GARDENS \$85

Community and school gardens provide essential nutrition and improve food security within communities, which is needed now more than ever. This gift provides seeds. equipment, fencing and other supplies for one community or school garden.



INDIGENOUS FOOD FOREST FUND \$250

Unlike a traditional farm, a food forest is self-sustaining once established. This means it can feed families for generations while helping Indigenous communities re-establish food sovereignty. This gift, which includes plants, soil, fertilizer, tools, fencing and irrigation, will contribute to the establishment of food forests in four Indigenous communities.



FRESH FOOD BOX \$45

Fresh food boxes are a welcome supplement to family nutrition, especially in communities where fresh food is unaffordable and where it's hard to get to shops due to distance and weather. Your gift provides a family with a box of fresh food that could consist of wild game, locally harvested and preserved food, and supplemented with other fresh food as needed.



GREENHOUSE \$55

Greenhouses help to start growing seedlings for gardens to get food earlier in the year. With Canada's short growing season. especially in northern regions, greenhouses will help grow more food to feed more people. Your gift will contribute toward building greenhouses and outfitting them with work benches, pots, and soil.



TRADITIONAL FOOD HARVESTING CAMP \$35

Learning to harvest from the land is important for Indigenous communities to achieve food sovereignty and to pass on knowledge about the land and how to live off of it to younger generations. Your gift will support seasonal overnight camping trips to fish, hunt moose and gather wild food like berries and beneficial plants.

Your gift will support land-based meals by purchasing equipment, such as fishing poles, trapping equipment and snowshoes.



COMMUNITY SOUP KITCHEN \$65

With the increasing cost of food, having a community soup kitchen helps to offset the cost of food for families and community members. Your gift will provide community meals in Indigenous communities in Canada.

School meals have a profound impact on a child's education and well-being. For 11-year-old Zainabu from Uganda, school meals are more than just sustenance; they are a gateway to a brighter future. Zainabu does well in her math classes and when she grows up, she would like to be a banker. Her parents are committed to support her education to achieve her goals, but with their limited income they struggled to pay all the fees to keep their three children in school. That changed when they started to receive support from Canadian Feed The Children supporters like you.

Zainabu now has all her school fees paid and receives school meals. With each meal, Zainabu told us that her concentration sharpens, her enthusiasm for learning ignites, and her energy becomes infectious in the classroom. School meals not only nourish her body but also fuel her mind, helping her to do better in school.

EDUCATION



Give the gift of education! Education is essential to break free from poverty and improve financial and food security for the future. Make sure children have everything they need to stay in school and succeed.



SCHOOL SUPPLIES: FOR A CHILD \$18 | FOR A CLASSROOM \$270

Your gift gives primary school students the essential items they need for a successful year of learning. Due to the increasing cost, parents are struggling to purchase the school supplies that their children need. This gift includes notebooks, textbooks, pens, pencils, and a ruler for children in an international community.



GIRLS' EDUCATION \$75

When a girl stays in school longer, she improves her future earning potential, allowing her to build a better life for herself, her family, and her community. This gift contributes to community advocacy to encourage parents to keep their daughters in school, school clubs promoting gender equality, and school supplies for girls in international communities.



SCHOOL UNIFORM \$29

Your gift of a school uniform – usually mandatory but often unaffordable – allows a child to enroll and stay in school, boosts their confidence, and gives them a sense of belonging.



READING BOOKS \$15

SCHOOL FEES \$54

In many developing countries the cost of education is one of the biggest obstacles to keeping children in school, especially in rural communities. Not only are the fees high, they are usually due at a time when parents are waiting for farming income to come in. This gift will provide a contribution toward the school fees for one secondary school child.



DESKTOP COMPUTER \$450

In many developing countries girls often do not have access to sanitary pads and they will frequently miss school during menstruation. LATRINE \$125

Latrines improve hygiene and are essential to keeping children, especially adolescent girls, healthy and in school. Your gift will contribute to building latrines at schools.

Bees are great for the environment too! This gift provides beekeeping training and start-up supplies.



IRRIGATION SYSTEM \$549
